CANDIDATE OVERVIEW

This candidate is a 30+ year electrical field leader with a career built entirely on large-scale, high-complexity projects across industrial, mission critical, and infrastructure environments. He is currently completing a large institutional project in the Midwest and is targeting a long-term W2 superintendent role with a nationally operating electrical contractor where he can deploy his field leadership experience on the kinds of projects he knows best. His most recent major work spans a hyperscale data center program across two major site campuses, covering underground, medium voltage, interior build-out, and commissioning on projects valued between \$80M and \$100M with crews exceeding 100 electricians.

Prior to his data center work, he built his reputation running some of the heaviest industrial electrical scopes in the Southeast and Mid-Atlantic, including a \$100M tire manufacturing plant, a \$100M power plant turbine upgrade program scaling four units from 830MW to 980MW, a 132-unit utility-scale wind farm valued at \$60M, and a \$50M aluminum plant build. Across all of these, he managed multi-layered field teams ranging from foremen and journeymen up through multiple direct-report superintendents, coordinating manpower loading, production sequencing, subcontractor activities, and schedule compliance simultaneously. His background spans more than two decades of progressive field leadership across two industrial electrical contractors, giving him the technical fluency and crew management instincts to step onto an unfamiliar site and run it independently from day one.

He holds an OSHA 30 and a valid driver's license, and is comfortable operating in Procore, Microsoft Project, Primavera P6, and Bluebeam. He is open to travel nationwide, available within two to three weeks, and is specifically seeking a company-truck environment given the scale of the sites he manages. He is motivated by project complexity, a stable long-term W2 structure, and a compensation package that reflects the level of responsibility he has consistently carried in the field.
