CANDIDATE OVERVIEW

This candidate has spent 28 years in industrial and commercial electrical construction, moving from installer through estimator, foreman, superintendent, and project manager. He currently serves as Senior Project Manager and General Superintendent for an electrical contractor on a data center in the Southeast, where he runs daily superintendent meetings, owns the schedule, coordinates with the general contractor, leads safety alongside the site safety representative, handles monthly billing, and resolves field conflicts before they reach the critical path. That project is roughly a week from completion as he works the final punch list.

He has worked both sides of the table. As MEP Project Manager for a national general contractor he managed mechanical, electrical, and plumbing scopes on a large food manufacturing facility in West Texas, owning subcontracts and estimates, processing RFIs, change orders, and submittals, inputting monthly pay applications, running weekly client and subcontractor meetings, and holding trade partners to schedule. He has extensive experience managing mechanical and refrigeration subcontractors alongside electrical scope, and he is equally comfortable working for a general contractor or an electrical contractor.

His mission critical background is current and substantial. Before his present assignment he spent approximately two years on a 120MW data center in the Pacific Northwest, where peak manpower reached about 180 workers. As Area Superintendent with a regional electrical contractor he owned QA/QC, planning, purchasing, and safety on an aerospace satellite manufacturing building, a commercial rocket manufacturing building, and a semiconductor processing plant, each in the \$18M to \$21M range.

He prefers the superintendent seat to a desk-based project manager role and is direct that his best work is in the field running crews. He is a career traveler with no hesitation about a multi-year on-site commitment, reads schematics, one-lines, and drawings at an expert level, and holds journeyman licenses in three states.
