CANDIDATE OVERVIEW

CND316492 is a Texas Master Electrician with more than 25 years in commercial and industrial electrical construction, progressing from foreman through to senior superintendent. He is currently Electrical Superintendent with Jomar Electrical on a roughly 75MW data center near Midland/Odessa, where he owns field execution, manpower management, and project delivery. That project is winding down, which is what has him exploring his next assignment.

Data center work is the center of his background. Across roughly ten years with PDI Service Group he ran a 700,000 square foot data center build on a 28-month duration, directing 11 foremen and approximately 185 electricians within his own organization, with peak site manpower reaching about 325. His wider project history spans hospitals and medical facilities, educational and financial institutions, hospitality and resort developments, public infrastructure, and energy facilities, with career project value exceeding \$355M.

Technically he covers power distribution and switchgear, instrumentation and controls, PLC systems and variable frequency drives, and arc flash analysis and grounding, working in BIM, Bluebeam, and Primavera. His priority is a Texas-based role that moves him back toward San Antonio or Austin.
