CANDIDATE OVERVIEW

This candidate is a construction manager with 20 years leading field operations on telecommunications, fiber, underground utility, and civil infrastructure projects. He runs work from preconstruction through closeout — scheduling, material procurement, budgets, change orders, invoicing, subcontractor coordination, city inspections, and final walk-throughs. He currently holds a traveling construction management role and is seeking a permanent position in the El Paso market, where his family is based.

He is a hands-on field leader who routinely manages five or more subcontractors at once alongside internal crews and vendors, and he owns crew productivity, quality control, and schedule from the ground up. He enforces site-specific safety plans and Job Hazard Analyses, holds OSHA 30, OSHA 10, and the Safety Trained Supervisor (STSC) credential, and coordinates daily with city and county inspectors on code and permit compliance.

His experience maps to the sitework, underground utility, and infrastructure scope of a data center build: underground conduit systems, trenching, micro-trenching, horizontal drilling, utility coordination, and restoration. Representative projects include military base fuel-system infrastructure, cell tower foundations with concrete equipment pads and underground conduit, and private fiber connectivity into hospitals and commercial buildings. He works in Microsoft Project and Excel and is bilingual in English and Spanish.
