CANDIDATE OVERVIEW

This candidate is a Tucson-based HVAC Service Technician with approximately 5.5 years of direct HVAC experience, including the past 2.5 years focused heavily on commercial and residential service, preventive maintenance, troubleshooting, and repair. During his tenure with Temco Air, he transitioned into service and was specifically assigned commercial accounts as the company expanded its commercial maintenance workload. His experience includes package units, split systems, gas furnaces, heat pumps, air handlers, ductwork, thermostats, airflow balancing, load calculations, and complete residential and commercial HVAC systems.

His commercial experience includes independently managing an assigned service route and performing complete heating and cooling maintenance for commercial customers. One of his larger accounts consisted of a facility with approximately 41 HVAC units, including numerous aging R-22 systems. He was responsible for evaluating equipment condition, checking refrigerant pressures, amp draws, compressor windings, gas pressures, and heat exchangers, identifying leaks and failed components, recommending equipment replacement when appropriate, and taking ductwork measurements to support replacement installations.

In addition to HVAC, he brings a broader skilled-trades background that includes plumbing, commercial construction, building maintenance, electrical work, remodeling, blueprint reading, and mechanical troubleshooting. He spent approximately 5.5 years with the same HVAC employer before being laid off following ownership and organizational changes and is currently available to start immediately. While he does not have significant chiller experience, he brings a solid conventional commercial HVAC service foundation, EPA refrigerant-handling certification, strong mechanical aptitude, and a demonstrated willingness to continue developing technically.
